that contains Gothic buildings built during the zenith of Barcelona's wealth and culture in the Middle Ages. A guided tour within the cathedral, which dates back to the 13th century, will give you the opportunity to admire the interior, suitably impressive with a fine nave and soothing cloister. From there, you will drive along one of Barcelona's most famous streets, the Passeig de Gracia, lined with the highest concentration of different Modernist buildings in the city. Many of these were designed by architect Antoni Gaudí.

Watch for Casa Batlló and Casa Milà, also known as La Pedrera. The next stop will be at one of Gaudí's masterpieces—the Sagrada Família (Holy Family) Church, a sight not to be missed. It was started in 1882 but is still unfinished. It is the most-visited building in Barcelona, and immediately identifies the city around the world. This temple was initially a neo-Gothic project designed by the architect Francesc de Paula del Villar, but Gaudí was commissioned to continue the work in 1891 and worked on it until his death in 1926. All the elements of the temple, both architectural and ornamental, reveal biblical symbols. From Sagrada Família, you'll head up to the El Mirador Alcalde viewpoint overlooking the Barcelona and its impressive harbor.

## Castle & Mausoleum Tour BXN004



Approximately 3½ hours • \$49

Meet your guide and walk to the Castle of Bodrum, where you will view its five towers. To obtain stone to build the Castle, the Knights of Rhodes tore down the Mausoleum of Halicarnassus, a magnificent tomb that was one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. A highlight of the tour will be a visit to the Sunken Boat Museum, with artifacts found underwater dating from the Bronze Age through the Middle Ages, including cargo from a Syrian trade ship (13th century BC). You will also visit the Carian Princess section to see a beautiful tiara of gold. Next, you will walk to the Mausoleum, which is Bodrum's oldest antiquity and one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, built by Artemisia II in honor of her husband King Mausolos. The general term for a large tomb is derived from his name. The entire structure stood at over 150 feet tall. The Mausoleum features frescoes and other objects, some of which are now on display in the London Museum. Then you will walk back down to the port.

Please note: This is a walking tour involving many steps which have been worn smooth with time and can therefore be slippery. Wear comfortable, rubber-soled shoes. As some
