you will enjoy a typical Ligurian lunch. In the afternoon, start your boat ride back to La Spezia with a couple of stops en route. The first will be at Vernazza, the most beautiful of the Cinque Terre villages and a seaside resort. The village slopes down towards the sea with secluded narrow alleys and a small square. A Gothic-Ligurian-style church dedicated to Saint Margareth of Antioch dominates the square. Then, an hour-long boat-ride will bring you to Portovenere, a 12th-century village with a 16th-century fortress. Spend an hour here browsing on your own, then board the dayboat back to La Spezia.

Add-on sightseeing to go with your transfer to the airport or to your Windstar hotel (guests must already have a prepaid transfer voucher or will need to buy one prior to purchasing this tour)

Add this sightseeing tour to your existing transfer arrangements. The tour will begin with a drive around Lisbon as you enjoy a number of special highlights: the Avenida da Liberdade with its mosaic-lined sidewalks, Black Horse Square and the Park Eduardo VII which offers magnificent views of the city. You will stroll through the cobblestone streets of Lisbon's old Alfama Quarter—a maze of narrow alleys and steps, flower-

bedecked balconies and courtyards with washing hung out to dry at the windows. There is a medieval atmosphere that has resisted every corrosive influence that time has been able to throw at it. You will also visit the church of the Jeronimos Monastery—a masterpiece of Manueline architecture. This building is widely acknowledged to be the finest sight in Lisbon, built in the 16th century to commemorate the discoveries of the Portuguese navigators. Nearby you will see the lavishly decorated Belem Tower, where Portuguese explorers were given a rousing send-off, and the Monument to the Discoveries, built to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the death of Prince Henry the Navigator, the mastermind behind Portugal's voyages of exploration and subsequent wealth. On the way to the hotel you will see, stretching across the River Tagus, the April 25th Bridge, sister to the Golden Gate Bridge of San Francisco, and the towering *Christ the King* statue on the far side.

Please note: This tour will end either at the airport or at your Windstar hotel. This tour is available only to guests whose flight leaves at 3:00pm or later, or to guests staying overnight in Lisbon.

Tuscan Landmarks: Florence & Pisa Tour LIV002

Depart from the port at Livorno by deluxe coach. Your journey to Pisa takes approximately 40 minutes and passes through the countryside of western Tuscany. On arrival at Pisa, you will have about 40 minutes of free time at the amazing Piazza dei Miracoli UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here you can wander past the Leaning Tower, viewing it from all angles, as well as the famous Cathedral and Baptistry. Across the street is a row of street stalls selling everything from inexpensive souvenirs to gorgeous leather bags. Next, re-board your coach for the approximately 1¼-hour freeway drive to Florence.
